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POST-OPERATIVE CARE OF WOUNDS

- 1. Remove bandages after 24 hours. Routine bathing and showering may be resumed after 24 hours. Cleanse wound after bathing or showering.
- 2. After removing bandages, the wound should be cleansed gently with soap and water.
- 3. Allow wound to dry, then apply ointment (ex: Vaseline, Polysporin or Bacitracin) and cover with a bandage. Cleansing and bandaging should be repeated twice a day until your follow-up appointment if you have sutures. If you do not have sutures, you can stop wound care when completely healed.
- 4. If you experience excessive oozing, bleeding, yellow or foul smelling discharge, you should contact our office immediately.
